

## TIES PROCEDURES

In the case of ties for league standings the following procedures will be followed:

*ALL SCHOOLS MUST BE PRESENT (AD or Coach) when a coin toss takes place.*

- A. 3-way tie for 1<sup>st</sup> Place
  - 1. Head to head win(s) determine 1<sup>st</sup> place
    - i. Remaining 2 teams play for 2<sup>nd</sup> place
  - 2. All 3 teams flip a coin. The odd man out takes 2<sup>nd</sup> place and the other two teams play for the #1 seed. The team that hosted the league game during the year will be the visiting team for the play-in game. Loser of this game is out of the playoffs.
  
- B. 2-way tie for 1<sup>st</sup> Place
  - 1. Head to Head win(s) determine 1<sup>st</sup> place (head-head from regular season)
  - 2. Coin flip determines 1<sup>st</sup> place
  
- C. 2-way tie for 2<sup>nd</sup> Place: (if more than 2 teams in playoffs)
  - 1. Head to Head win(s) determine 2<sup>nd</sup> Place
  - 2. Coin flip determines 2<sup>nd</sup> place
  
- D. 2-way tie for 2<sup>nd</sup> Place: (if only 2 teams in playoffs)
  - 1. Head to Head win(s) determine 2<sup>nd</sup> place
  - 2. tied teams play 1 game to determine 2<sup>nd</sup> place
  
- E. 3-way tie for 2<sup>nd</sup> Place: (if 4 teams in playoffs)
  - 1. Head to Head win(s) determine 2<sup>nd</sup> place
    - i. Remaining 2 teams play for 3<sup>rd</sup>
  - 2. Coin flip determines position (First flip odd team gets 2<sup>nd</sup> place- 2<sup>nd</sup> flip one team calls flip for 3<sup>rd</sup> place)
  
- F. 3-way tie for 2<sup>nd</sup> Place (if only 3 teams in playoffs)
  - 1. Head to Head win(s) determine 2<sup>nd</sup> place
    - i. Remaining 2 teams play for 3<sup>rd</sup>
  - 2. Coin flip (odd team is in as #3 and other 2 teams play for 2<sup>nd</sup> spot)
  
- G. 3-way tie for 2<sup>nd</sup> Place: (if only 2 teams in playoffs)
  - 1. Head to Head win(s) determine 2<sup>nd</sup> place
  - 2. Coin flip (odd team sits out, other two teams play and winner plays the team that sat out)
  
- H. 2-way tie for 3<sup>rd</sup> Place (if 4 teams in playoffs)
  - 1. Head to Head win(s) determine 3<sup>rd</sup> place
  - 2. Coin flip determines 3<sup>rd</sup> place

- I. 2-way tie for 3<sup>rd</sup> Place: (if only 3 teams in playoffs)
  - 1. Head to Head win(s) determine 3<sup>rd</sup> place
  - 2. Tied teams play 1 game to determine 3<sup>rd</sup> place
  
- J. 3-way tie for 3<sup>rd</sup> Place: (if 4 teams in playoffs)
  - 1. Head to Head win(s) determine 3<sup>rd</sup> place
    - i. remaining two teams play for 4<sup>th</sup> place
  - 2. Coin flip determines 3<sup>rd</sup> place (odd team goes in as #4, other two play for #3 spot.
  
- K. 3-way tie for 3<sup>rd</sup> place (if only 3 team in playoffs)
  - 1. Head to Head win(s) determine 3<sup>rd</sup> place
  - 2. Coin flip (odd team sits out, other two teams play and winner plays team that sat out)
  
- L. 2-way tie for 4<sup>th</sup> Place:
  - 1. Head to Head win(s) determine 4<sup>th</sup> place
  - 2. Tied teams play 1 game to determine 4<sup>th</sup> place
  
- M. 3-way tie for 4<sup>th</sup> Place
  - 1. Head to Head win(s) determine 4<sup>th</sup> Place
  - 2. Coin flip (odd team sits out, other two teams play and winner plays the team that sat out)
  
- N. ANY OTHER POSSIBLE SITUATIONS NOT COVERED WILL BE DECIDED BY THE EXECUTIVE BOARD.

\*\*\*\*\*If possible, All Play-in games are hosted by the team that DID NOT host the league game during the regular season. If this is not available, the game can be hosted by the other team or both teams can search for a neutral site.
